



CALL FOR APPLICATIONS

Case Research Journal Editor 2022-2024

The NACRA Executive Board invites applications for the *Case Research Journal* Editor for the period January 2022 to December 2024.

Deadline for applications: June 4, 2021, 5pm EDT

The *Case Research Journal* Editor is an appointed officer for a period of three years, as per Section 4.4.d of the NACRA Constitution. The current *Case Research Journal* Editor's term of office extends until the end of the Annual Meeting, although the current Editor has kindly agreed to stay on until the end of 2021 to be responsible for completing this calendar year's volume 41. The NACRA Executive Board approved the continuation of Christina Tathibana, as Editorial Assistant, until the end of 2022.

Application process

NACRA members who have published in the *Case Research Journal* and have reviewed for the *Case Research Journal* are eligible to apply. Interested applicants need to provide an updated Curriculum Vitae, as well as a 1,500 – 2,000-word statement of editorial intent. The statement should discuss the applicant's vision for the *Case Research Journal*, including identifying specific opportunities and risks facing the publication, and discuss the applicant's experience relevant to the Editor's duties, as outlined in Section 1.3.b of the NACRA Constitution. Applicants are required to submit their two application documents in PDF format to Michael Goldman, NACRA President, at mmgoldman@usfca.edu, by June 4, 2021, 5pm EDT.

Selection process

The NACRA Executive Board has constituted a selection committee that includes previous *Case Research Journal* Editors and other members of the Board. The selection committee will consider all applications and invite short-listed applicants for video-conference interviews. The selection committee will forward a recommendation to the Executive Board, that will make a decision by the end of September 2021. The new *Case Research Journal* Editor will be introduced to the membership at the Annual Meeting in mid-October and participate in an editorial handover process until January 2022.
